

Recipient countries for EU-funded Mine Action abroad 2012-2016





On 17 August 2017, the Council of the EU adopted Decision 2017/1428 in support of the implementation of the Mine Ban Convention.

Through the Decision, the EU seeks to:

- promote the universalization of the Convention**
- support efforts on the part of States Parties to implement the victim assistance, mine clearance, and stockpile destruction aspects of the Maputo Action Plan**

The Convention's Implementation Support Unit has been entrusted to serve as the technical implementer for the Council Decision.
